Bishop Herman Hicks



Bishop Herman Hicks is the Jurisdictional Bishop of Kansas Southwest Jurisdiction, which is made up of 31 churches in Wichita, El Dorado, Dodge City, Garden City, Liberal, Salina, and Junction City, Kansas. Additionally, he had proudly served as the Pastor of Greater Pentecostal Church of God in Christ, in Wichita, Kansas for 22 years.

After 25 years on active duty in the United States Air Force, he retired from the military in 2005 in the rank of Colonel. His final military position was Commander, 22nd Mission Support Group at McConnell Air Force Base, KS. He was responsible for overseeing the support for over 4,000 military and civilian personnel, and an annual budget of \$98 Million, and \$416 Million in infrastructure. His most memorable military assignment was when he served as the first black Deputy Chief of Protocol for the United States Air Force Europe as a Major. In Nov 2021, he was honored by the City of Wichita, Kansas with a banner in downtown Wichita for his outstanding service while on active duty and his outstanding contribution to the community as a Veteran. The local PBS Channel in Wichita also honored him in 2021 as an "Outstanding Veteran." He served four years as the President of the Greater Wichita Ministerial League.

From 1990 – 1992, while still serving on Active Duty as the Deputy Chief of Protocol, he served as the Pastor of Maranatha Tabernacle COGIC in Mackenbach, Germany (the largest off base COGIC church in Europe). He also served as the Pastor of Tabernacle of Praise COGIC in Ft Walton Beach, Florida, while serving on active duty as Deputy Commander, Support Group at Eglin Air Force Base Florida. In April 2021, he was appointed by the Presiding Bishop of the Church of God in Christ, Bishop J. Drew Sheard, to serve as the Assistant Commissioner/Endorser, Military/Institutional Chaplaincy for the Church of God in Christ. On November 11, 2023, he was consecrated a Bishop in the Church of God in Christ during the Holy Convocation in Memphis, TN. He worked in the Church of God in Christ International Men Perfecting Men Conference for 18 years, spending the last 12 years as the Vice Chairman. For the past seven-years, Bishop Hicks served as the Chief of Staff for the International Holy Convocation Program Committee for the Church of God in Christ.

He completed his Bachelor of Arts degree in Political Science from the University of Mississippi in 1980, and a Master of Political Science/Criminal Justice from the University of South Dakota in 1982. In 2008 he was awarded an Honorary Doctor of Divinity Degree from St Thomas Christian College. He and his wife, Lady Anadina Hicks have four adult children and one grandson.




